### Speaker:

#### **Timothy B. Lescun, BVSc, PhD**

Associate Professor, Large Animal Surgery  
Purdue University College of Veterinary Medicine

Dr. Timothy Lescun attended veterinary school at the University of Melbourne in Australia and graduated in 1994. In 1999, he began his residency at Purdue University, earning his Certification as a Diplomate: American College of Veterinary Surgeons in 2000. He completed his PhD in 2015. Dr. Lescun's areas of interest are: local antimicrobial therapy for the treatment of septic arthritis in horses; agnosia and treatment of orthopedic infections; transfixation pin complications in the horse; evaluation of temperature generation and microdamage during drilling, tapping and pin placement procedures in equine bone; and use of low level vibrations to prevent bone loss during transfixation casting.

Dr. Lescun has authored numerous publications in the subjects of equine lameness and surgery.
