Dr. Barrett earned her DVM from Colorado State University. She then completed a year-long internship at Oakridge Equine Hospital, in Edmond, Oklahoma. Returning to CSU, she underwent a non-conforming radiology residency focusing on equine diagnostic imaging & training with equine imaging experts in the US and internationally. At the same time, Dr. Barrett obtained a master's degree through the Orthopaedic Research Center at CSU. Dr. Barrett is now the head of the equine diagnostic imaging service at CSU. Her primary research and clinical interests are equine musculoskeletal imaging and comparative imaging, and she works closely with the equine surgery and sports medicine services. In 2011, Dr. Barrett founded Inside Information Radiology, with her partner, Dr. Selberg. She has spoken at multiple large national meetings and is regularly involved in continuing education courses. Dr. Barrett is dedicated to the advancement of the specialty of equine diagnostic imaging and is currently the president of the Large Animal Diagnostic Imaging Society, a subgroup of the American College of Veterinary Radiology.
